**Fourth Sunday of Advent** 



This Advent/Christmas Season Augustana is incorporating resources on the theme of "From Generation to Generation". We are using an all-ages mural project, courtesy of a resource called "Way to Lead Ministries." This consists of 5 large colouring sheets, one for each Sunday in Advent, plus Christmas Eve, that when put together form a large mural which can eventually be displayed in our sanctuary. Anyone coming into the church at any time can do some colouring, but we especially encourage kids to participate in this activity—for example, during the Sunday sermon. This should be a fun and satisfying project which results in something beautiful we can all appreciate.

There will be two **Christmas Eve Services** this year at 6 and 8 PM with the 6 PM one also being livestreamed. Christmas Day's service will be at 10:30 AM. Communion will be served at the Christmas Day service only. Ushers are still needed for the 8PM Christmas Eve Service.
