As we enter the summer months when people can be away on holidays, just a thank you in advance for your continued contributions to Augustana, either in-person, through E-Transfers or by Preauthorized Remittance (PAR). For E-Transfers, simply log into your online or mobile banking app and select the account you wish to withdraws funds from. Enter the email augustana@sasktel.net and the amount, your envelope number and name along with the designation so the donation can be recorded for tax purposes. Then send. All e-transfers sent to the Augustana e-mail will automatically deposit to our chequing account.

PAR brochures/forms are available in the church narthex or you can contact the church office. One of the benefits of PAR is that it enables Augustana to have a better understanding of the income that will be received, which is helpful during the summer months. The application process is easy. It just requires your name and banking information, along with a void cheque and the amount you wish to give monthly. The funds will automatically be withdrawn from your bank account on the 20<sup>th</sup> of each month and deposited into Augustana's chequing account. If you ever wish to change the amount of your PAR giving or discontinue giving by PAR, just contact the church office. It is a very smooth process to set-up and allows Augustana the opportunity to better manage our finances.
