~ CANDLE 1 ~ Darkness

The 1st candle is lit Silent Reflection

The 3rd candle is lit Silent Reflection

Prayer: Loving God, we give you thanks for all the people who have been part of our lives over the years. Bless our memories of the loved ones who have died. Bless also the ones who are separated from us by time and space. We entrust them all to your loving care. Amen.

~ CANDLE 4 ~ Old Wounds

The 4th candle is lit Silent Reflection

Prayer: Loving God, we come to you in need of healing. May your healing peace bring release from past hurts. Help us to let go of the bad feelings and memories that harm us. Even as we entrust ourselves to your care, let us also entrust those old wounds to your care. Amen.

~ CANDLE 5 ~ Physical Challenges

The 5th candle is lit Silent Reflection

Prayer: Give us patience, O God. Let us be patient with ourselves when our bodies don't do what we want as quickly as we want. Let us be unafraid to seek help when we need it. We ask also for patience and acceptance in our world, so that no one would feel isolated because of physical challenges. Amen.

~ CANDLE 6 ~ Finances

The 6th candle is lit Silent Reflection

Prayer: Gracious God, remind us again and again of the precious things in life that have no dollar value. Let us remember that the most important gifts come through human kindness and caring. Thank you for the priceless gift of the baby in the manger. Amen.

~ CANDLE 7 ~ The unspoken

The 7th candle is lit Silent Reflection

Prayer: Emmanuel, God-with-us, you hear the silent cries of our heart — the ones that are so hard to put into words. Thank you for the assurance of your loving presence in our lives. May this assurance bring comfort and joy to us this day and all days. Amen.
