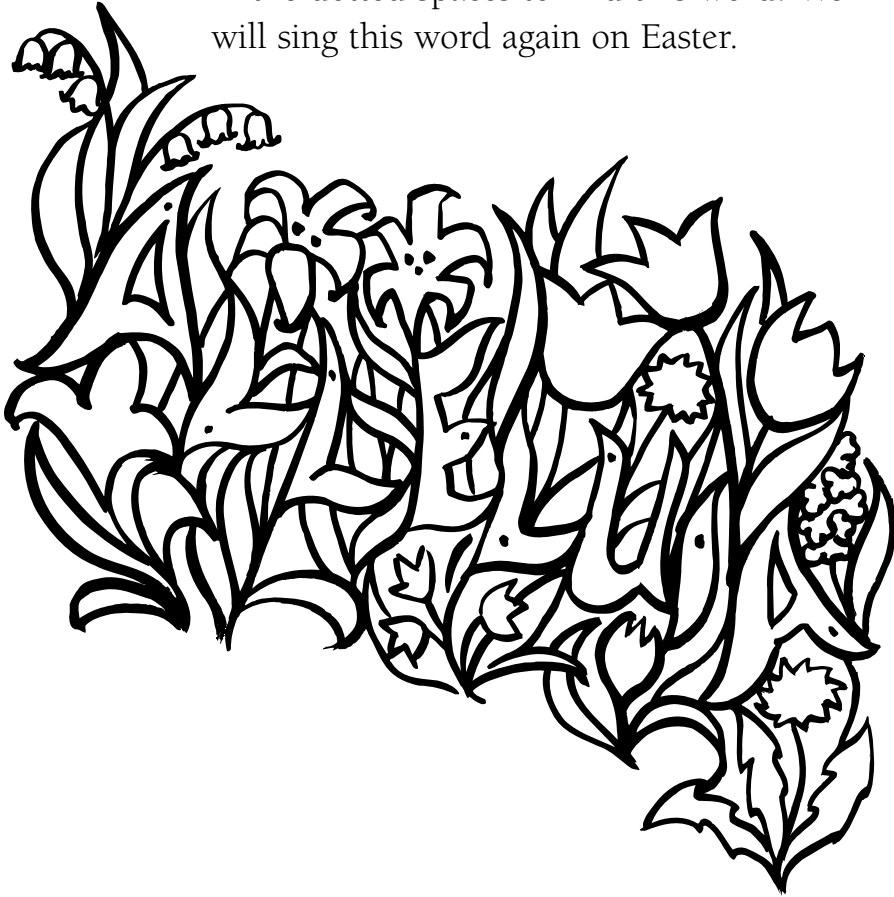


The word is out

During Lent, we give up something during worship. We put away a happy word. Color in the dotted spaces to find this word. We will sing this word again on Easter.



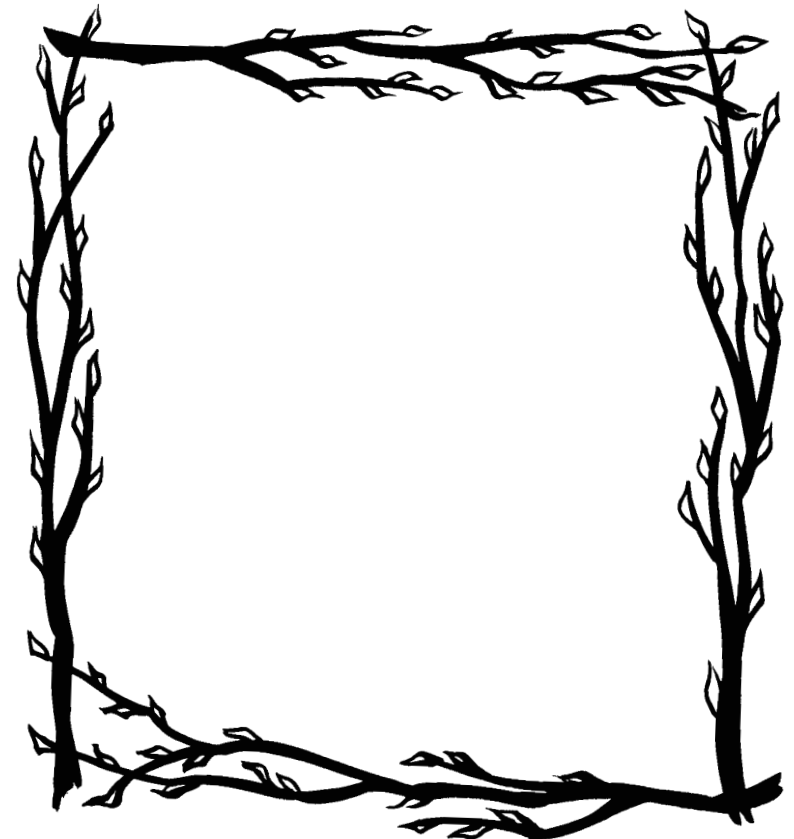
Dear God, please help me to pray each day as I wait for Easter—the best springtime surprise of all. Amen

The devil gave up and went away.

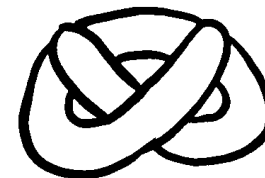
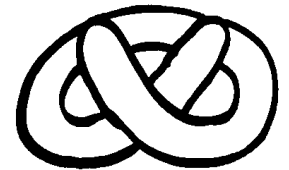
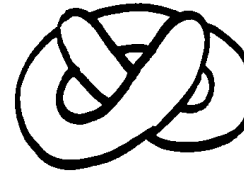


Prayers and pretzels

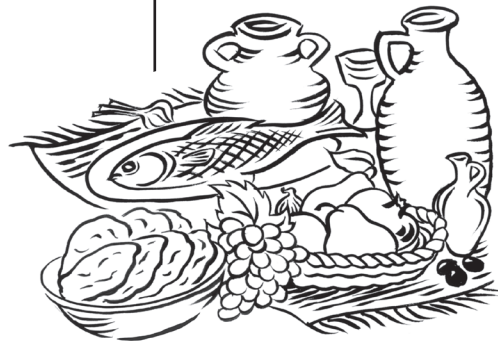
Turn these pretzels into praying people.

The memory verse says that God is like a fortress. A fortress is a safe and secure place. Draw a picture of a place where you always feel safe. Where is God in that place?



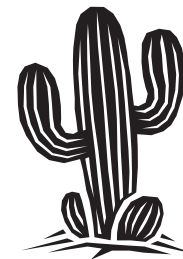

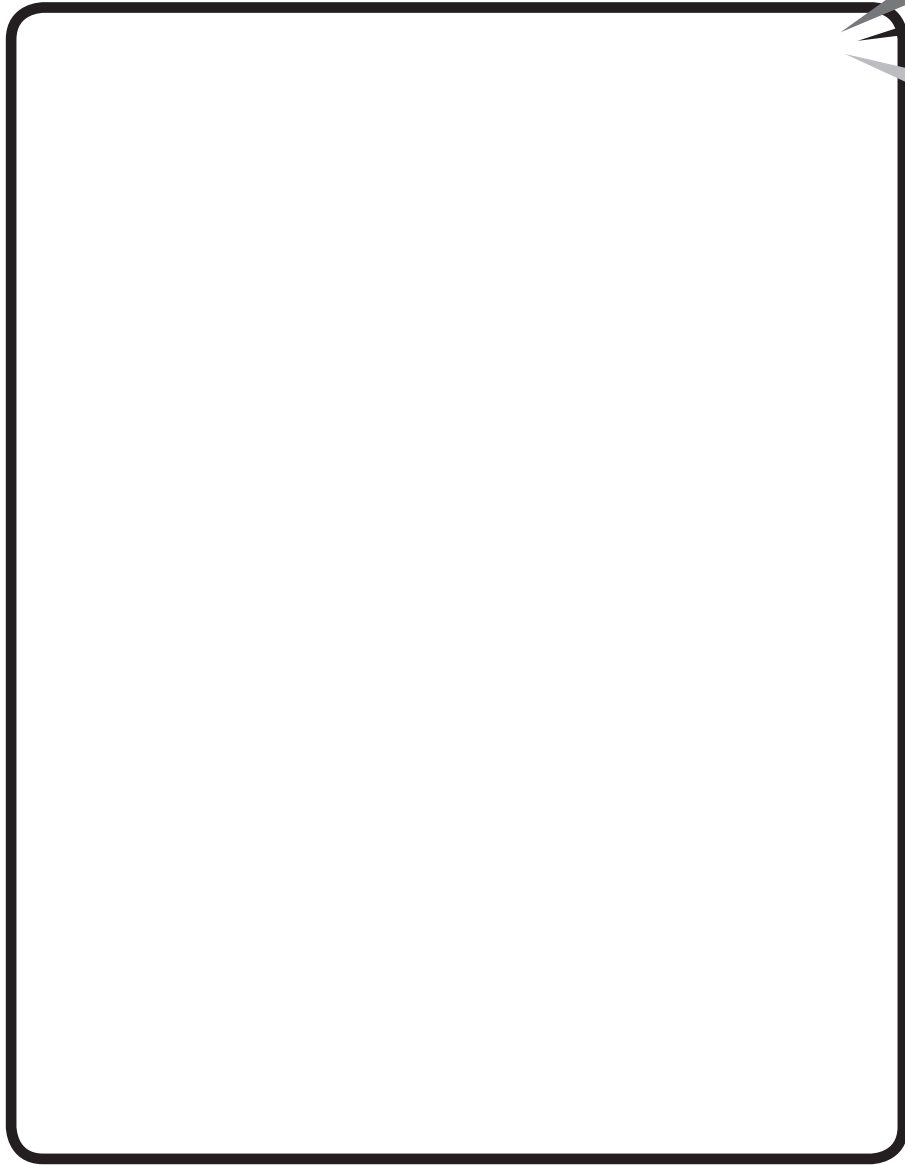

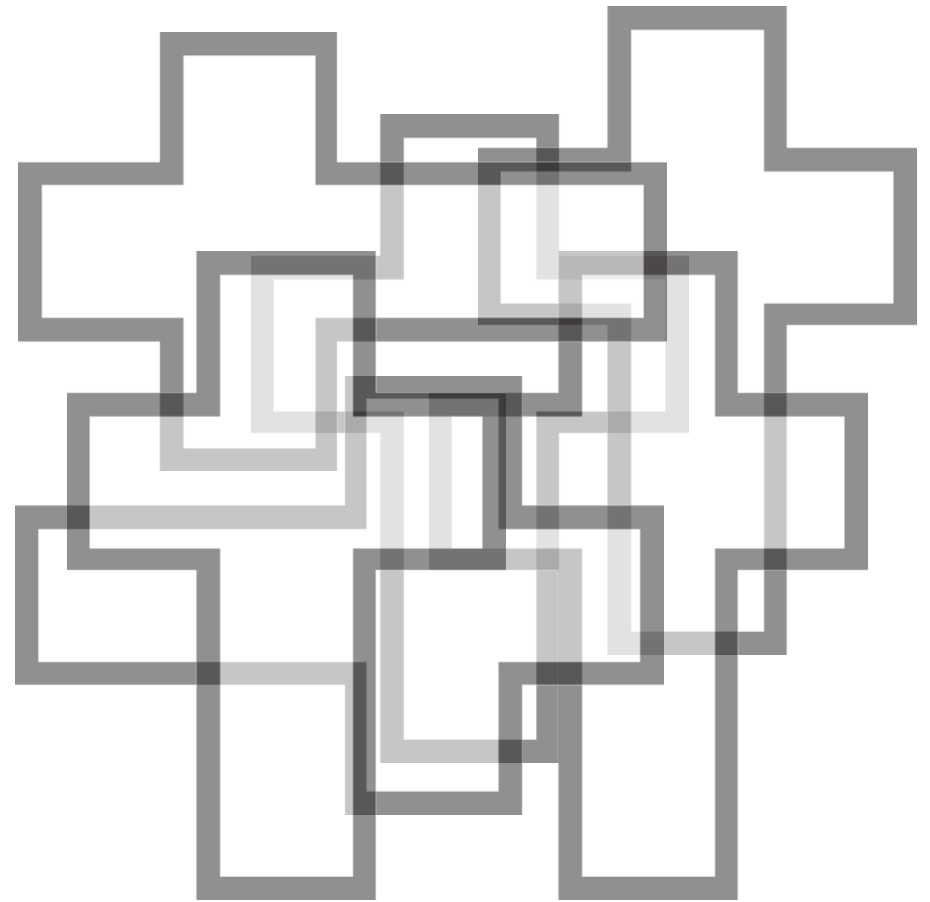
