

#### **Pouring out God's love**


Jesus was filled with God's love. You're filled with God's love, too. Out of love, Jesus changed water into wine. Out of love, how could you help these two?




In this picture, draw the faces of Jesus' friends who were sad because the wine was gone. Write *No wine!* in the cartoon balloon.

In this picture, draw the faces of Jesus' friends who were happy when Jesus turned water into wine. Write *Thank you!* in the cartoon balloon.


### Filling up with God's love

Some things you see in a worship service have a specific purpose. Others are for decoration because of their beauty. Some things are both. Look around your worship space and write some of the things you see in this diagram.








Epiphany 2









- Epiphany is the season between Christmas and Lent.

The Cross is the most important symbol of our Christian faith. It reminds us of Jesus' death and resurrection. Color the cross inside of the star.











