Opposites

Peter has a fantastic dream in today's story. In the space below, draw a picture of a hope or dream for your life, big or small.






Today's Bible story is about Peter's dream. This is not the first time God has spoken to people in the Bible through dreams. Look up these verses to find out who else had dreams.

Write down a tally of the number of people you count. See directions below on how to make tallies.


