


Spreading the good news

John 17:20-26 [15:5]

Jesus expected the disciples to carry on the work that he had begun. Jesus wanted the world to know that he was God's Son. Jesus prayed that the disciples would work together to spread this good news. One example Jesus had used before to help the disciples understand their job was this one: "I am the vine, you are the branches" (John 15:5).

We are the branches

God is always with you!



Below are two egg symbols that are very similar--but not the same! Can you find the seven differences between them? Look closely at the cross.




Below is a pop quiz. Read the questions and circle the answer that best describes what you would do in that situation. Then compare your answers to what Paul and Silas would do in the same situation.


