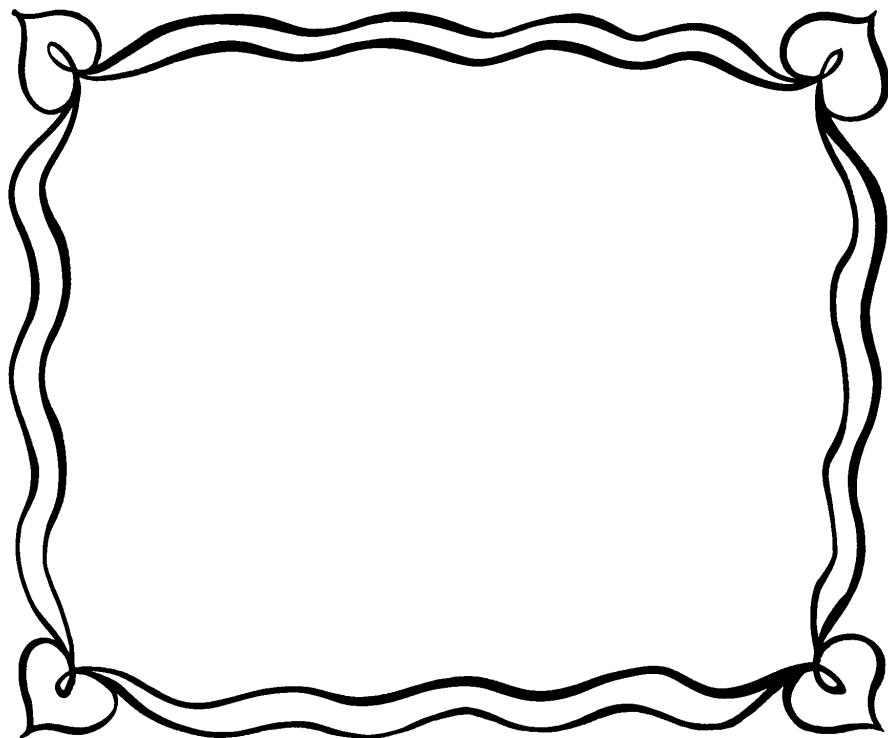

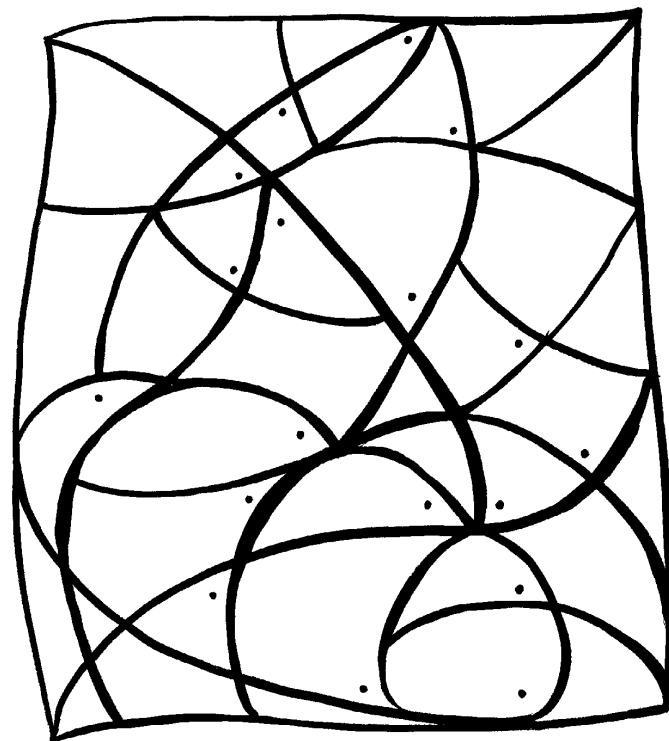

Today is the third Sunday of Easter. Today you will discover many ways to “see” Jesus.

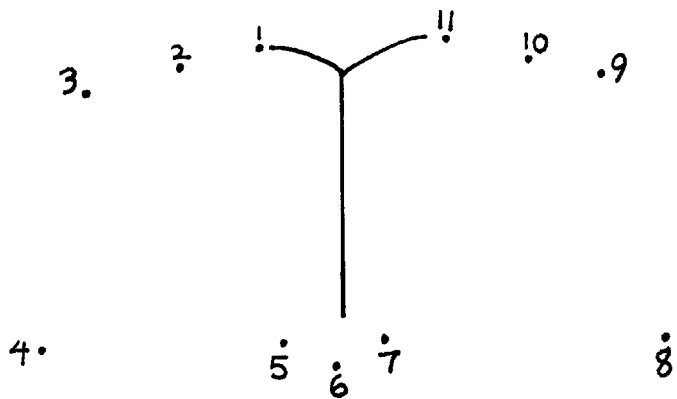


Color the dotted spaces to find a communion symbol. At communion we hear, “Do this to remember me.” We say, “Come, Lord Jesus. Amen.”

Luke 24:13-35

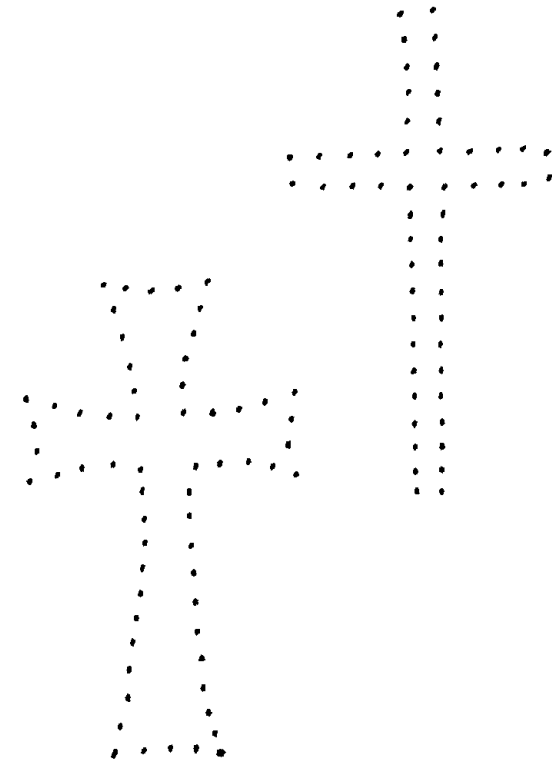
The disciples were walking on the road to the village of Emmaus (ee-MAY-us) when they met Jesus. They were still sad. They even told Jesus his own story because they did not recognize him. Finally when Jesus blessed the bread and offered it to them, the disciples really saw Jesus! They left quickly to tell others their good news.



We can't see Jesus like the disciples did.

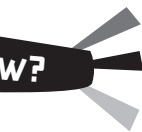
Who Do You Know?

 Set 4: Three 1-cent coins, two 1-cent coins, and a 10-cent coin -OR- one 5-cent coin and one 25-cent coin.

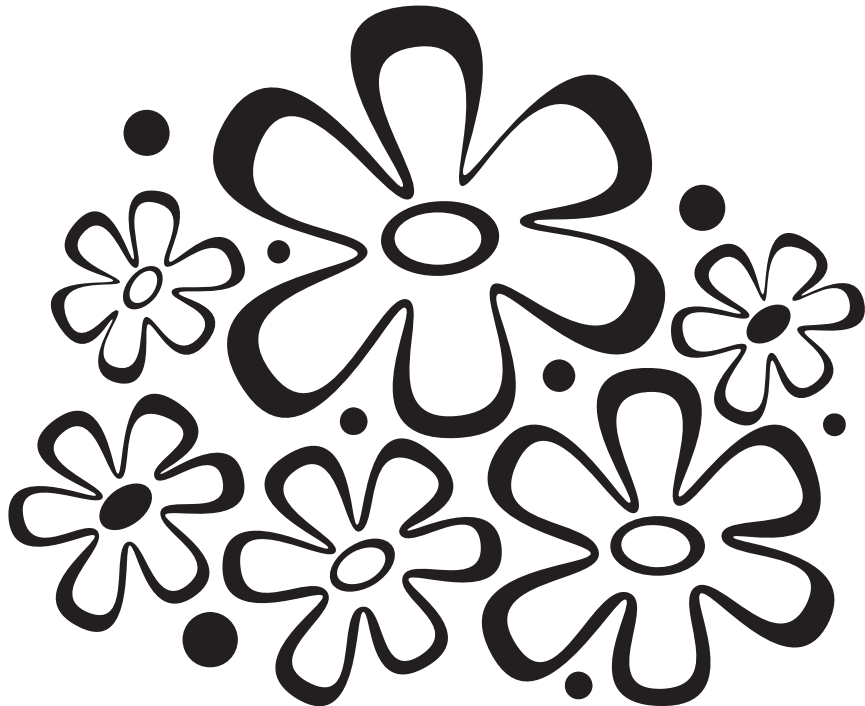
Using flowers in the worship space reminds us of new life.
