



John 14:1-14

Jesus taught his disciples how to believe in him: "Don't be troubled or worried. Believe in God, the <u>Father</u>, and in <u>me</u>. <u>I</u> am the <u>way</u>, and the <u>truth</u>, and the <u>life</u>. No one comes to the Father except <u>through</u> me."

Jesus reminded them to keep praying to God: "I will do whatever you ask in my name, so that the Father may be **glorified** in the Son. If in my name you ask me for **anything**, I will do it."

There may be a paschal candle in your worship space during Easter. This candle reminds us of the life and light of Jesus. The paschal candle looks like this. Do you see one?





Living Stones


Peter wrote a letter to his friends. He told them they were like living stones. By using the gifts God gave them, they could build a house for God on earth. Fill in your gifts on these stones.

There may be a candle that looks like this in your worship space. Do you see one?




Color this candle and then draw pictures of other candles you see in your worship space.




Draw a sun around this symbol for Easter to show the beginning of a new day.
