

Jesus Christ is risen!

John 20:1-18

Early in the morning, Mary Magdalene came to Jesus' tomb. She saw that the big stone was rolled away from the door. Jesus' body was gone!

Mary cried as she looked in the tomb. She saw two angels dressed in white. They said to her, "Why are

you weeping?" Mary said, "Jesus is gone." Then Mary turned around and saw Jesus standing there, but she did not know it was Jesus. Jesus said, "Mary!" When Mary heard her name, she recognized Jesus. Jesus told Mary the good news he had risen from the dead! Mary ran to the disciples. She said, "I have seen the Lord!"



When you hear someone say, "Christ is risen!" respond this way: "Christ is risen indeed!" Practice with a family member or a friend.

Easter eggs

Our celebration of Easter is filled with eggs. Jelly beans look like tiny, colorful eggs. We eat chocolate eggs and chew bubblegum eggs. We turn ordinary eggs into beautiful pieces of art. Eggs are a powerful symbol of Easter. The eggshell is like Jesus' tomb. It carries new life inside of it. When the chick hatches out of the egg, it reminds us of Jesus' new life at Easter.

Call and Response

In many churches, the pastor sings or says something named a *call*. Then the congregation sings or says something back. This is called a *response*. Many churches use a unique call and response on Easter Day and during the Easter season.




- Today is **Easter Day**.




Today's memory verse is about looking for Jesus. Look for the missing letters in the tomb Memory Verse below to complete today's verse. You can use each letter more than once.

Christ Is Risen!



Let's play I-SPY! On Easter Day, there are many festive things in worship.


Look around and see if you can find the following things:






- Today is **Easter Day**.
