

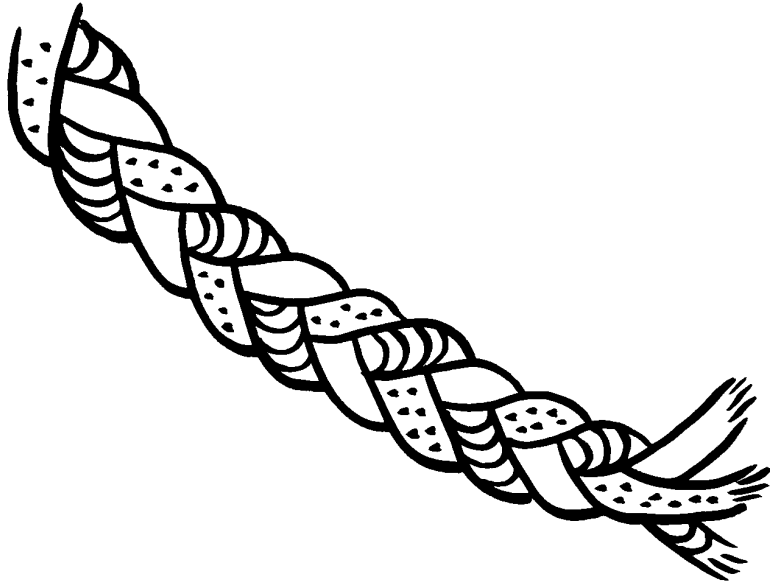

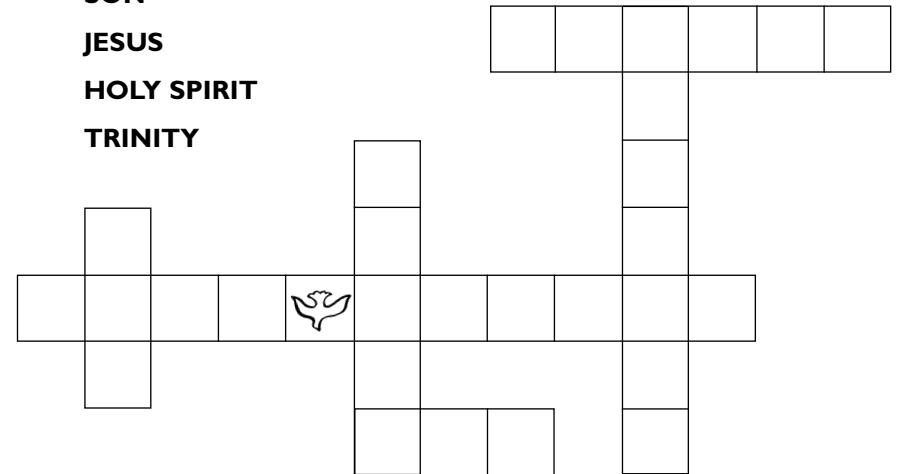

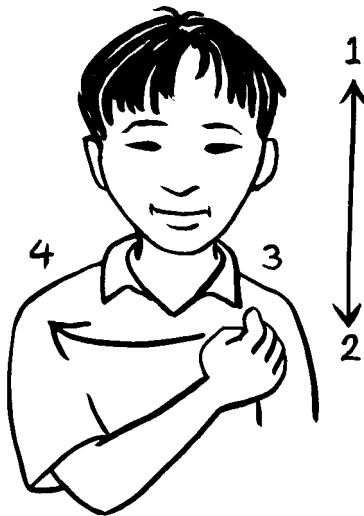


Three names

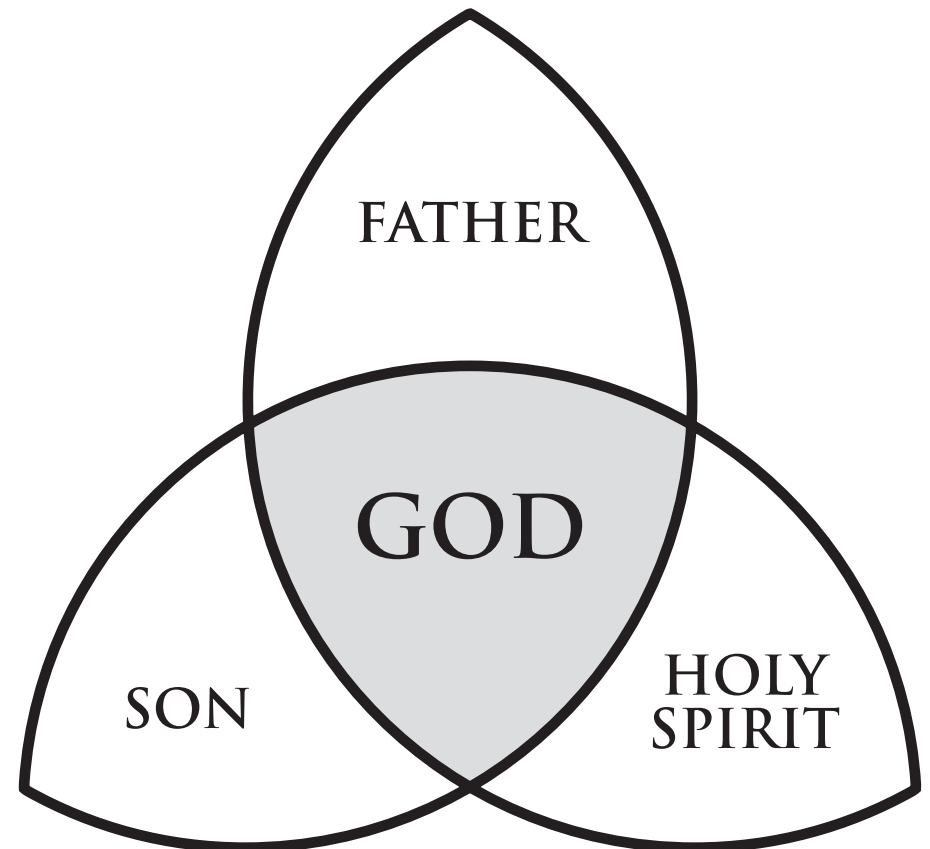

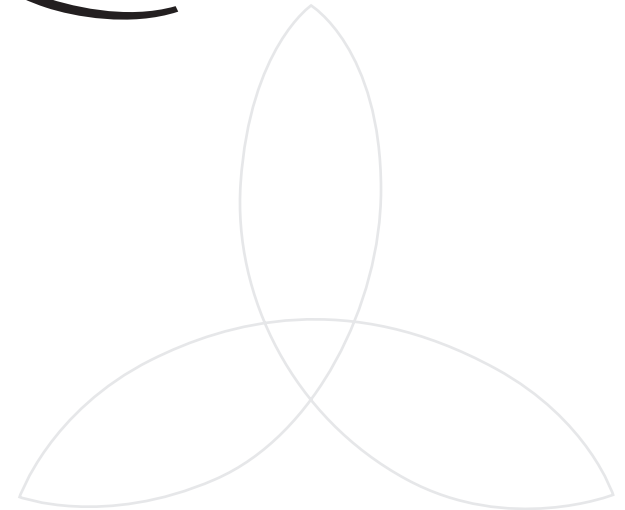
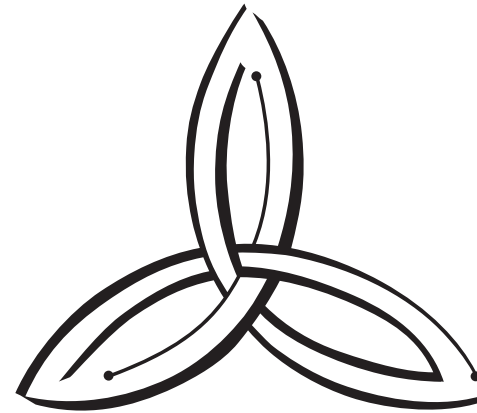
