





We can serve God instead of serving our money. If we worry about making money instead of serving God, our lives become as mixed up as the manager's story.










- Today is 15<sup>th</sup> Sunday after Pentecost.

- In Pentecost, we remember that worshipping God is more important than anything else!


#### Can You Climb This Tree!?




### Design Your Own Currency

Trees provide food for lots of different animals. Match the tree foods below with their eaters.
















