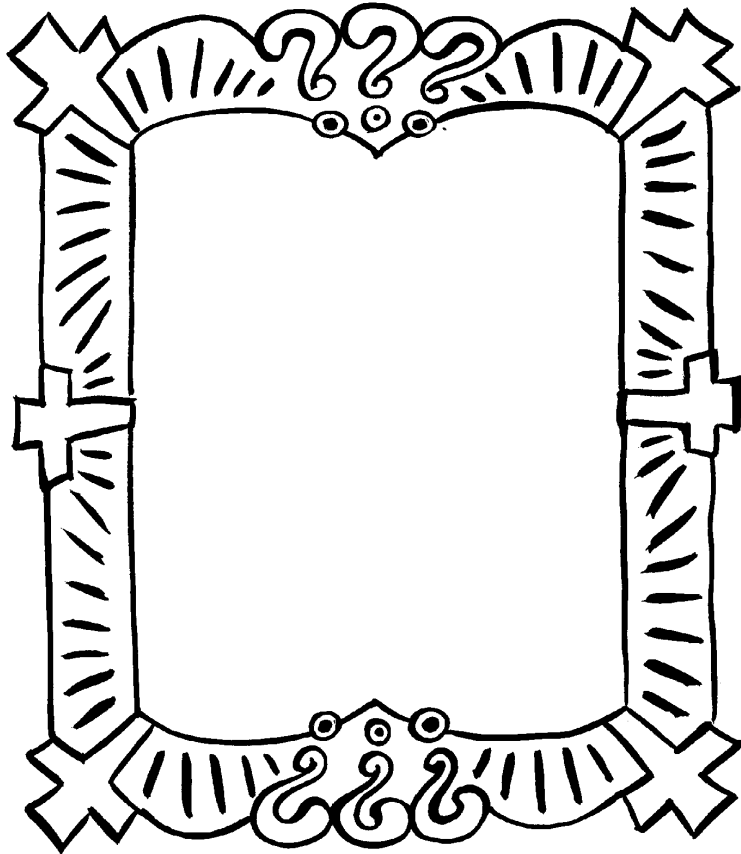

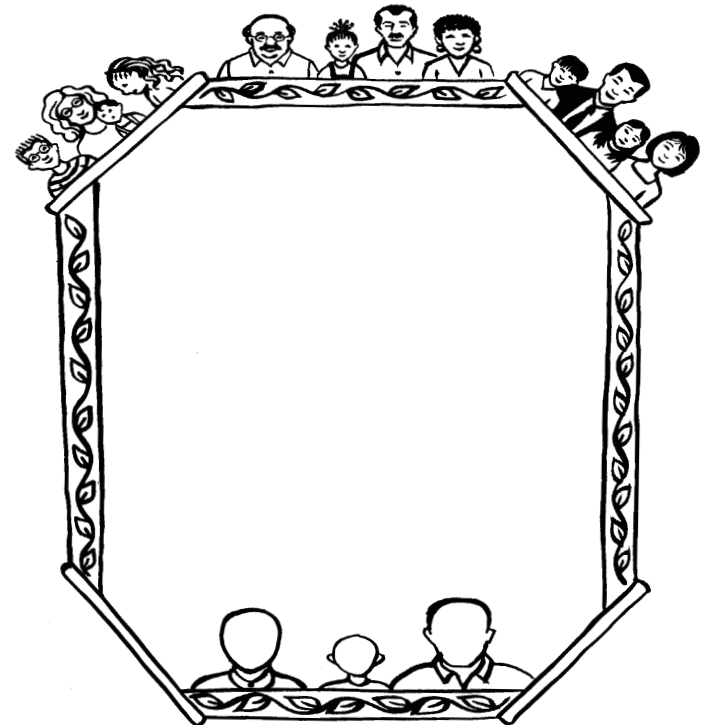
When you make a mistake, give yourself a hug and remember Jesus' forgiveness.

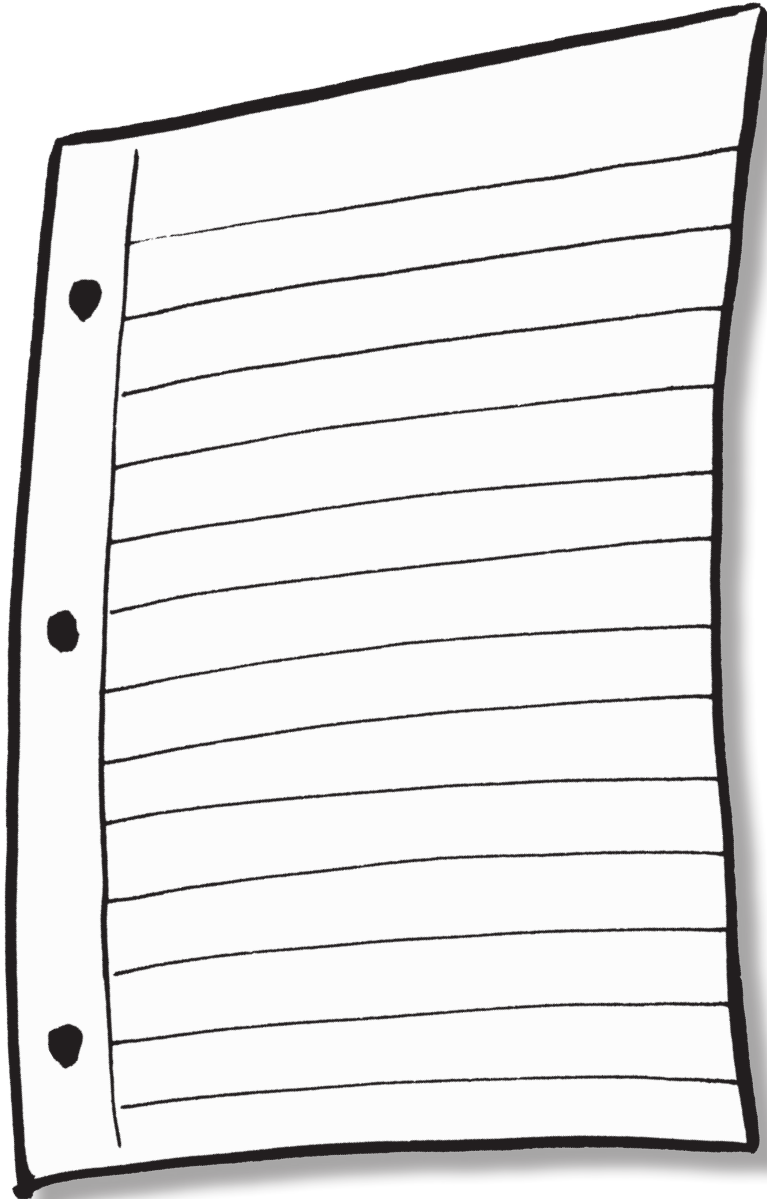

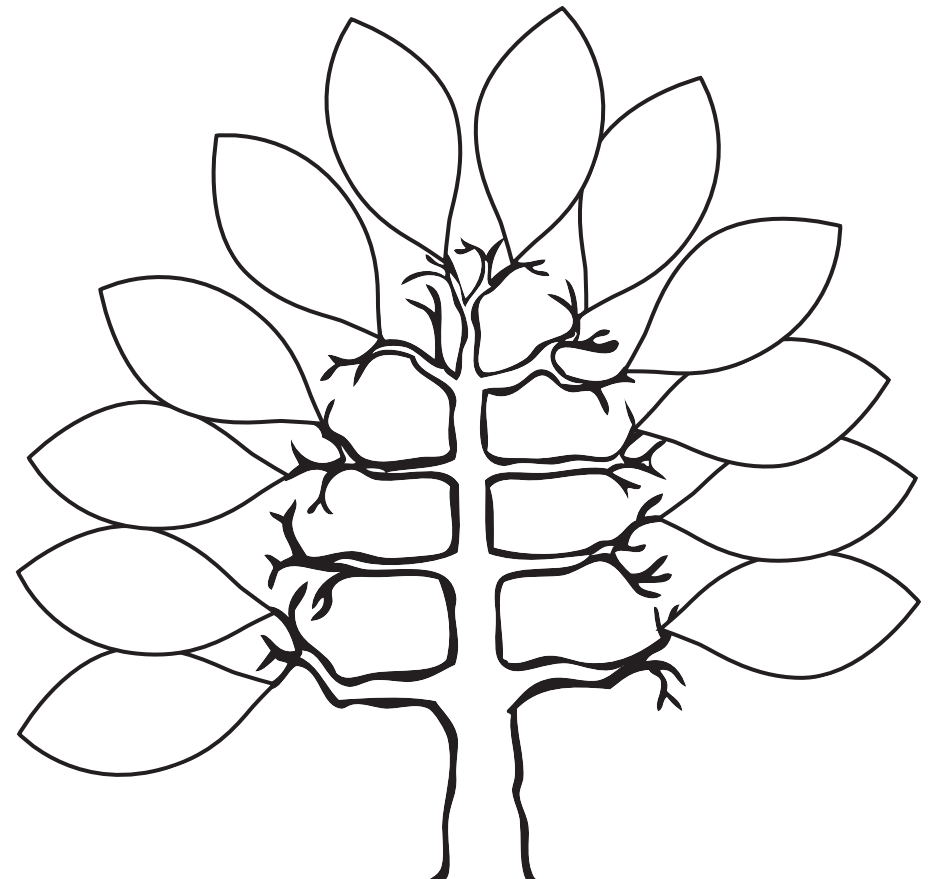
