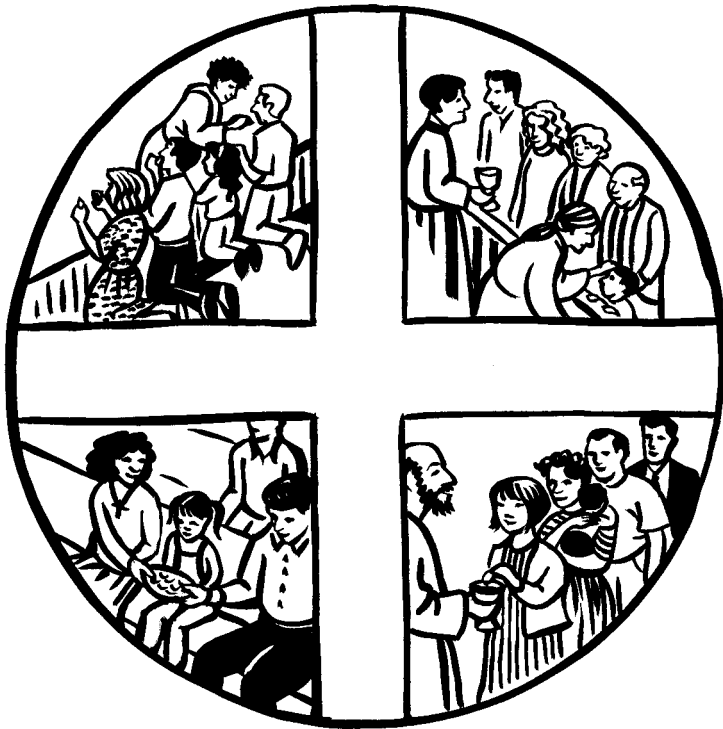


A fabulous feast

Create and decorate an invitation to the most exciting party you can dream up!

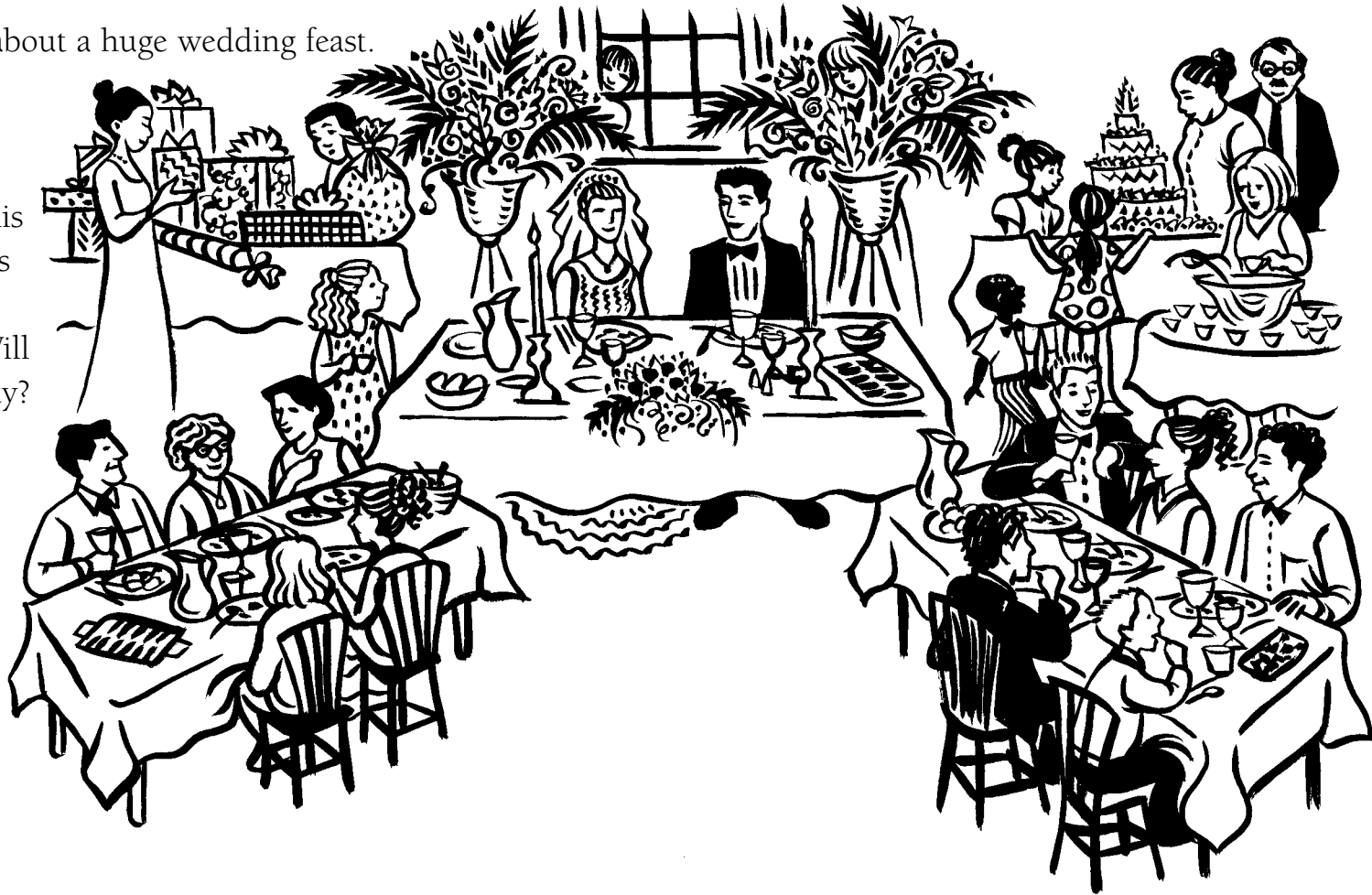

Draw yourself at this fabulous feast.

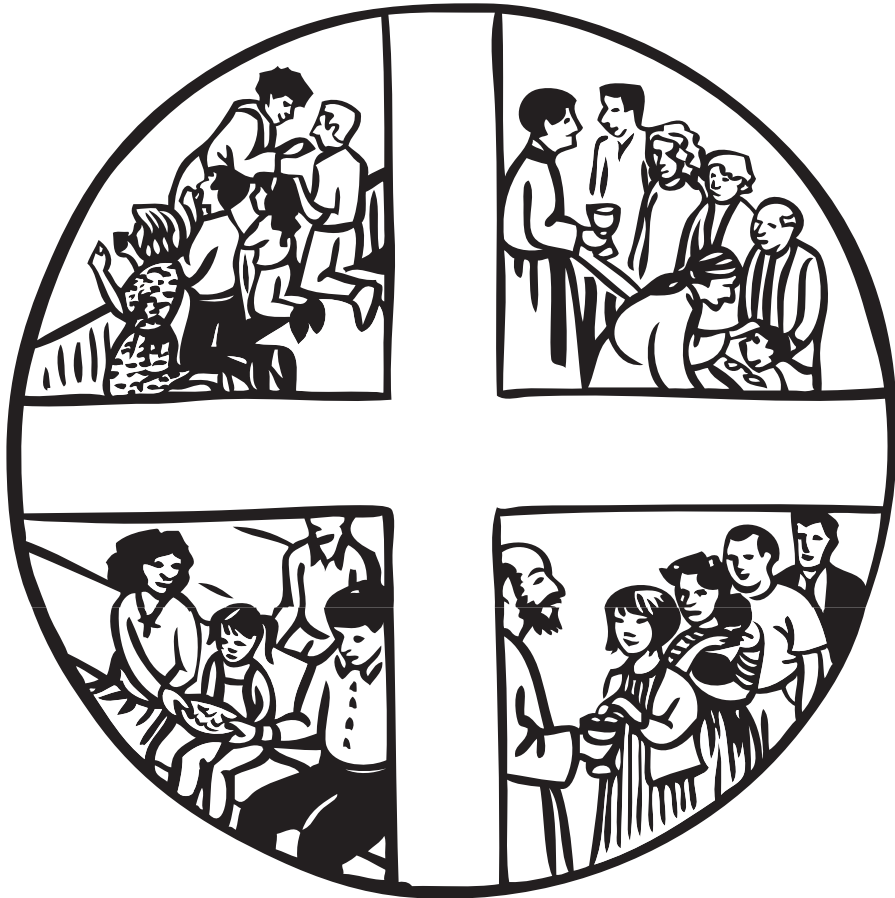
Find 3 people who don't feel welcome to join the party and are hiding.

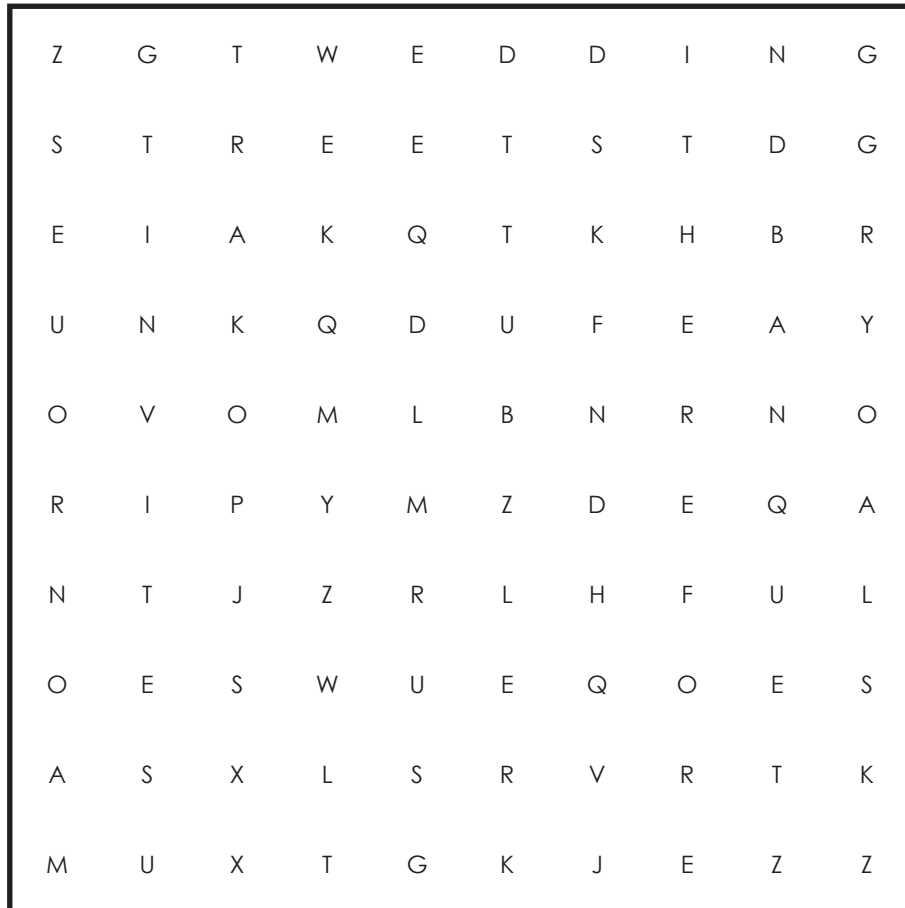
Go therefore into the main streets, and invite everyone you find to the wedding banquet.

The king sent his servants to find people to come to the banquet. Go on a hunt for words from the memory verse.

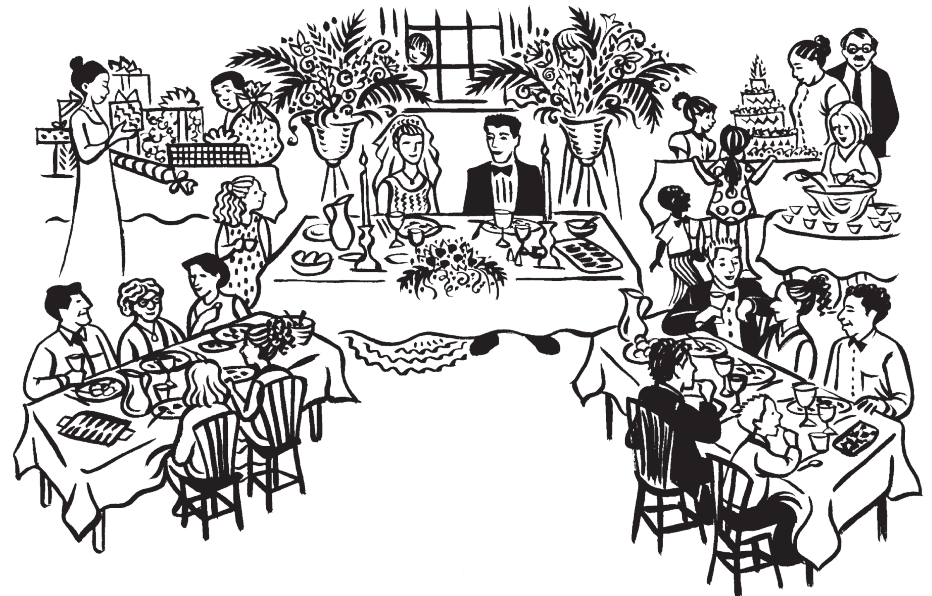


The Fabulous Feast

Draw in some more people in the empty spaces at the meal.

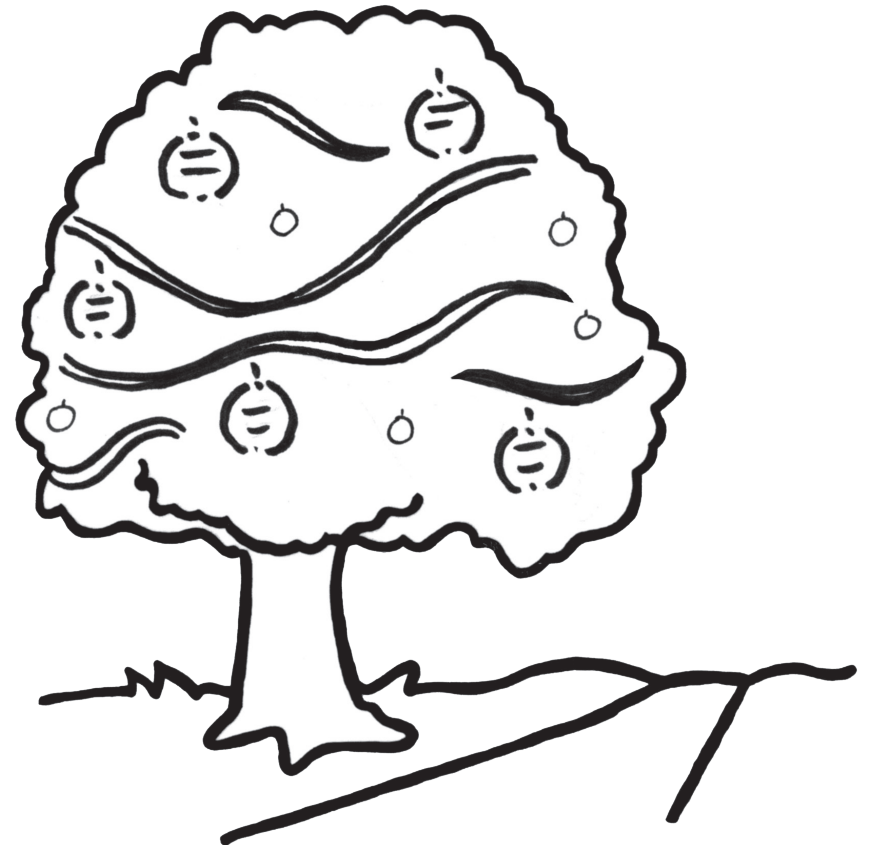


PRE-READER
