
Practice watching and waiting at home. Plant an amaryllis bulb and watch the new growth appear during the days of Advent.

First day of Advent: Find 4 candles to light—one on each of the 4 Sundays of Advent.


Wrap gifts together.





Jesus tells us to be ready. Decorating for the Advent season is one way we can get ready for Jesus.




