

#### Jesus' promise

John 15:26-27, 16:4b-15, Acts 2:1-21

Jesus' disciples were together in a house when suddenly a loud, rushing wind filled the room, and something that looked like flames touched each of their heads. 






- Today is the Day of Pentecost.

Day of Pentecost


- Today is the Day of Pentecost.

Color these two symbols for Pentecost.






Suddenly a strong wind blew through the house.
