


Watch for butterflies and hatching birds. Celebrate the new life of Easter!

"Forgive the sins of others," Jesus reminded the disciples.


"**I** send you, just as the Father sent me," Jesus told the disciples.



Crosses come in many different designs. Which crosses match? Find the matching pairs. Color each pair a different color.












Jesus' disciples met in a locked room. Suddenly Jesus stood with them! He said "Peace be with you."
