


Ways to love



John 15:9-17



What is your favorite part of the worship service?




Today is the 6th Sunday in Easter. In the grid below, color in all the multiples of 6. What image do you see?

God sent the Holy Spirit because God loves us. The Spirit lives in each of us. We can love because Jesus loves us.


Find and color 12 hearts that are the same. Then draw the Holy Spirit's flame inside each of the hearts.


