



Jesus called to them saying, "Follow me and I will make you fish for people." So, Simon, Andrew, James, and John all dropped their nets and followed Jesus. They became the very first disciples!

**Draw a picture of Simon, Andrew, James, and John following Jesus.**



Your pastor does many things during worship! A lot of other people are part of worship, too. Write or draw what different people besides your pastor do during the service.






- Green reminds us of **how we grow** with Jesus' help.


## From the Tree




## Bible Tip!




# PRE-READER

**Some of Jesus' disciples were fishermen. Circle the fish that tells us what week of Epiphany it is. Color the rest of the fish in different colors.**






**“Let’s catch people instead of fish.”**
