

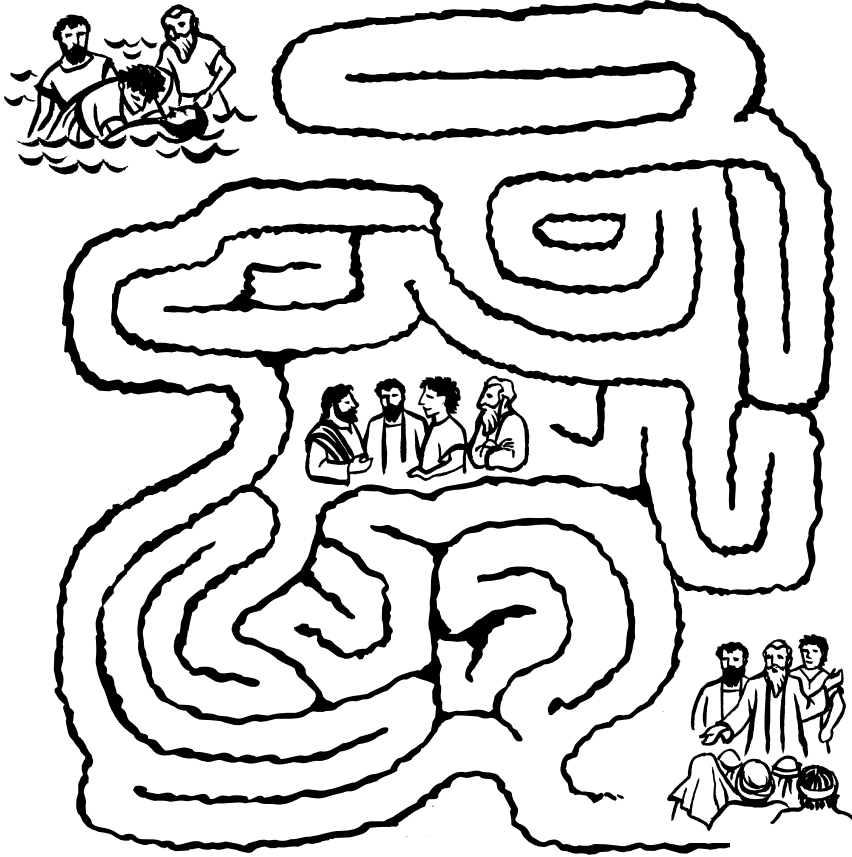

The Holy Trinity

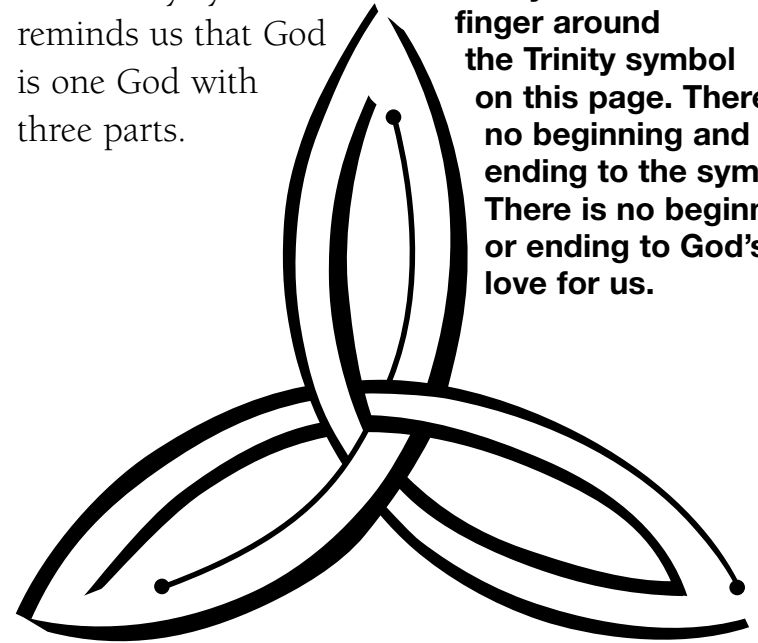

Color the circle by each part of creation as it is mentioned.

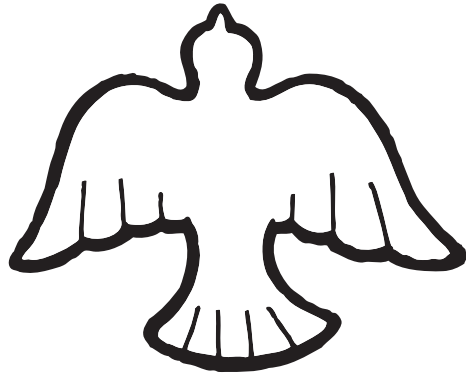
Use bright colors to finish coloring the whole picture of God's creation.

Trinity Symbols

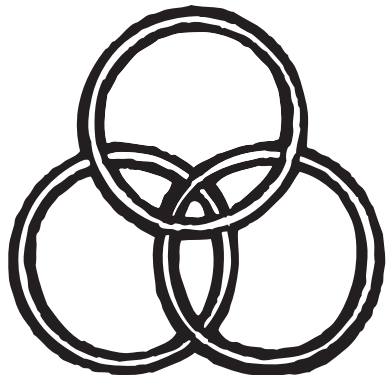
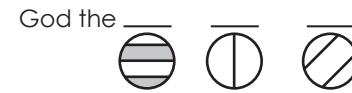
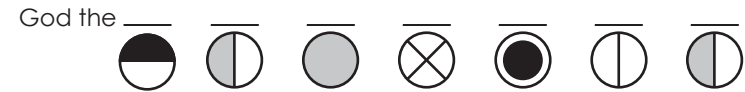
There are many symbols for the Trinity. Do you see any of them in your worship space today? If so, draw it in the space below. If not, design your own!

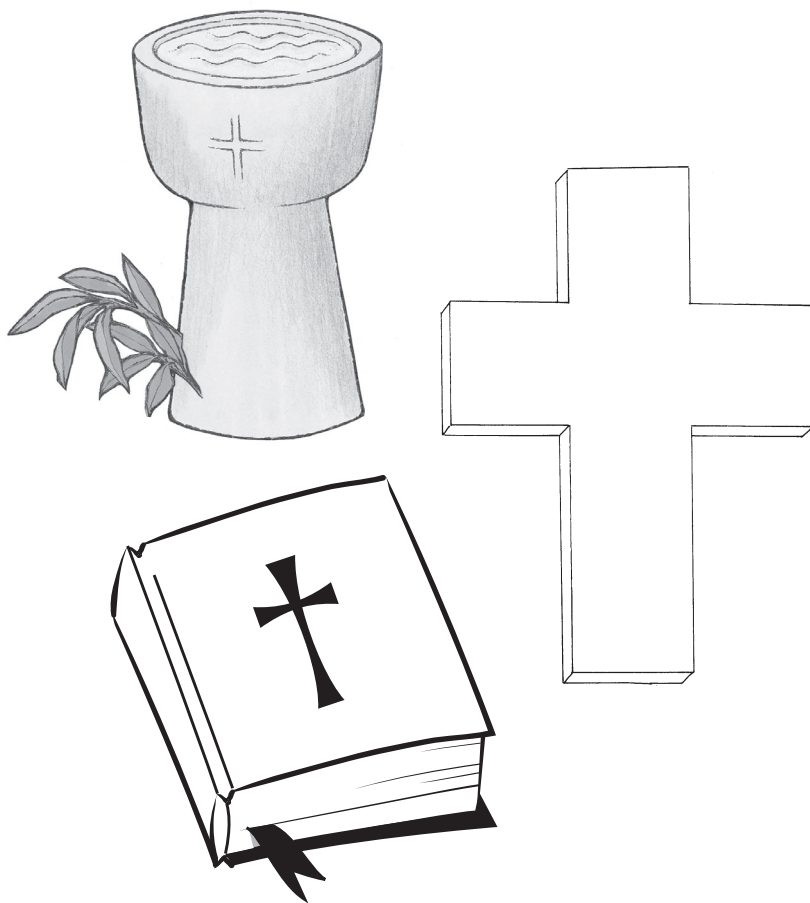
On Trinity Sunday, we remember that God created us. Look around your worship space. Can you find these three things?

The baptismal font helps us remember that the Holy Spirit is with us at our baptism and always!

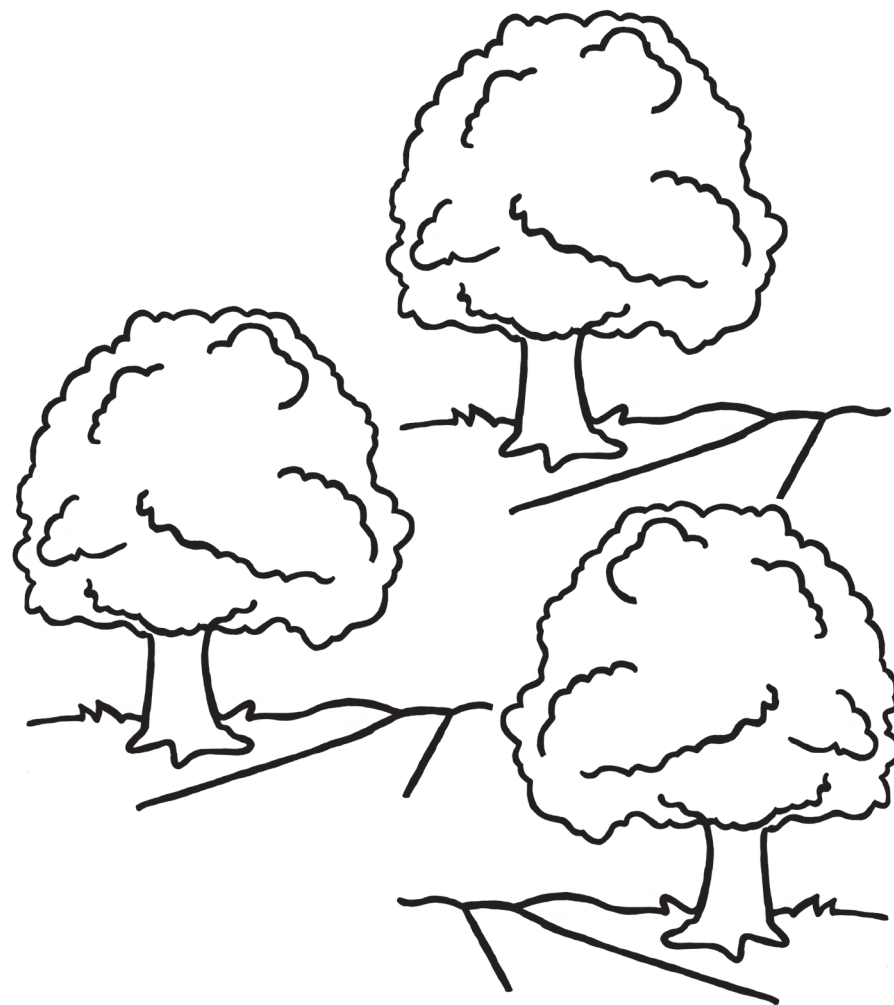
