Can you find and circle all 15 palm branches in this picture?





Does your church have palms for everyone today? Put one under this page and make a rubbing using the side of your pencil to show the texture. Then draw some coats on the road.




Palms Everywhere

On Palm Sunday, we wave palms in church to remember Jesus' entrance to Jerusalem. Fill in the missing palm to finish the pattern in each row.












One of the gospels doesn't have the Palm Sunday story in it. Can you figure out which one?

Make a rubbing of it on this page. Then draw what people do with their palms during worship.
















Palm Sunday
