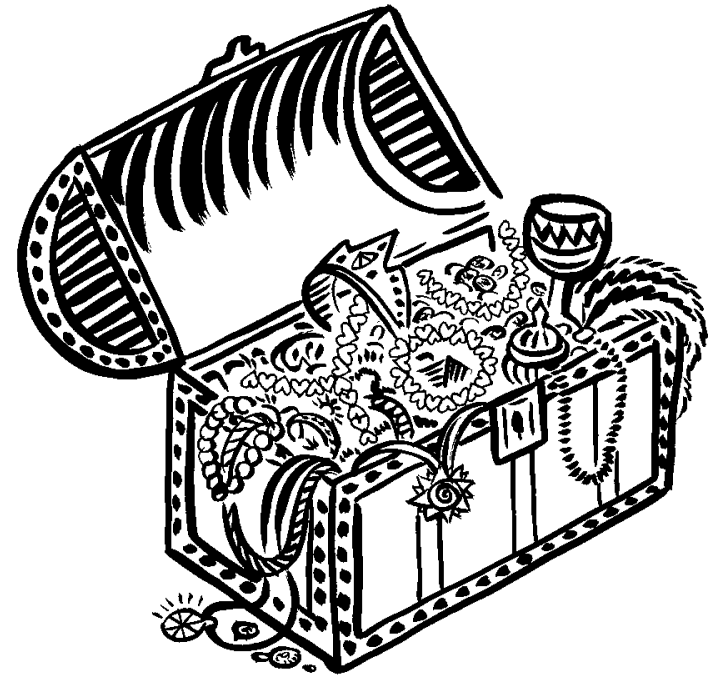

Welcome to worship. What is a treasure? It is something very important and valuable. Some people think money is the best treasure, but God has a different idea!

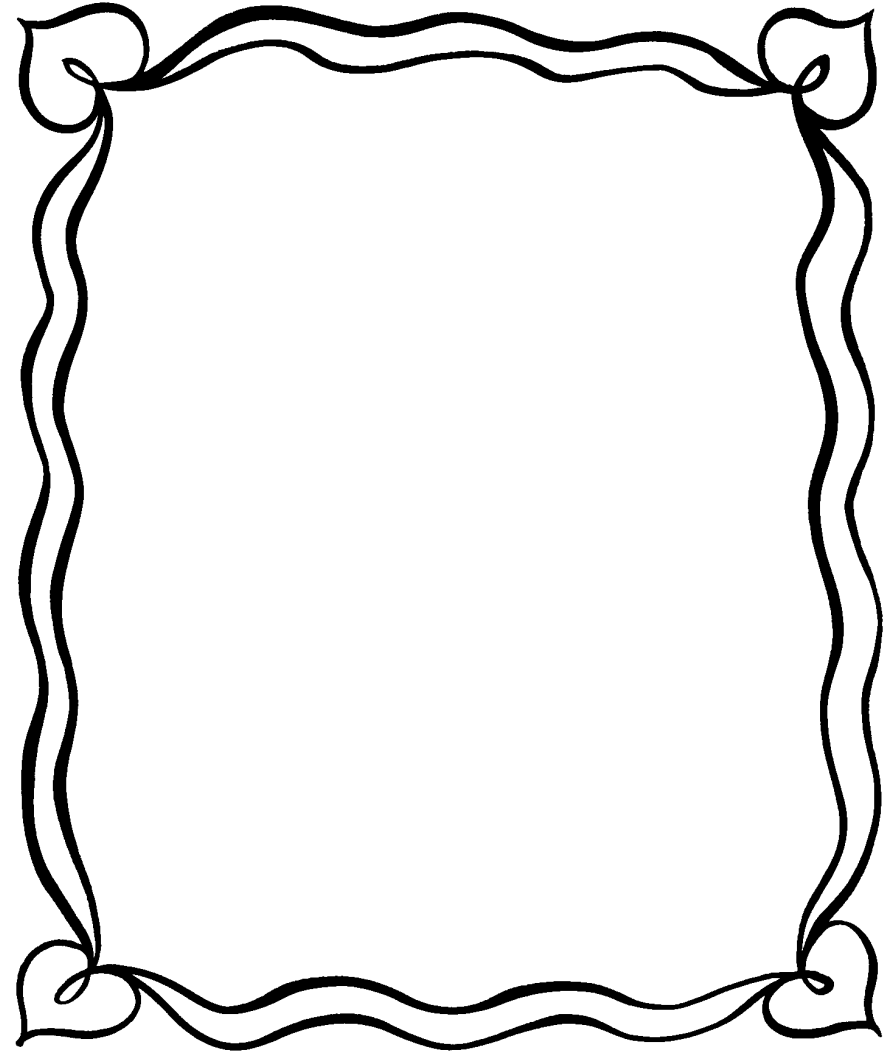
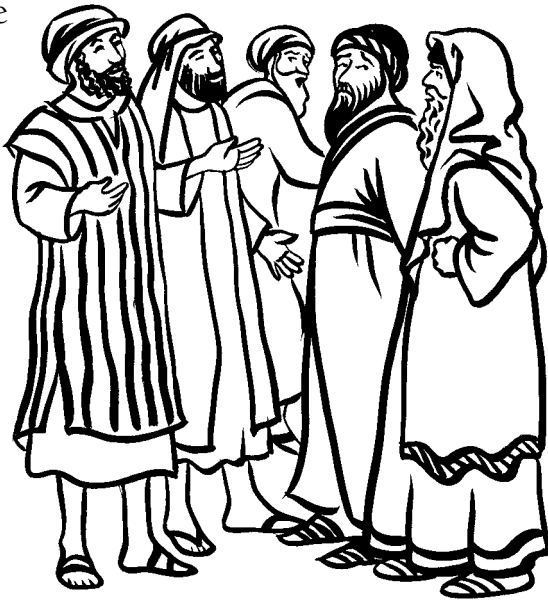


Color the tiny hearts to find out what God treasures.

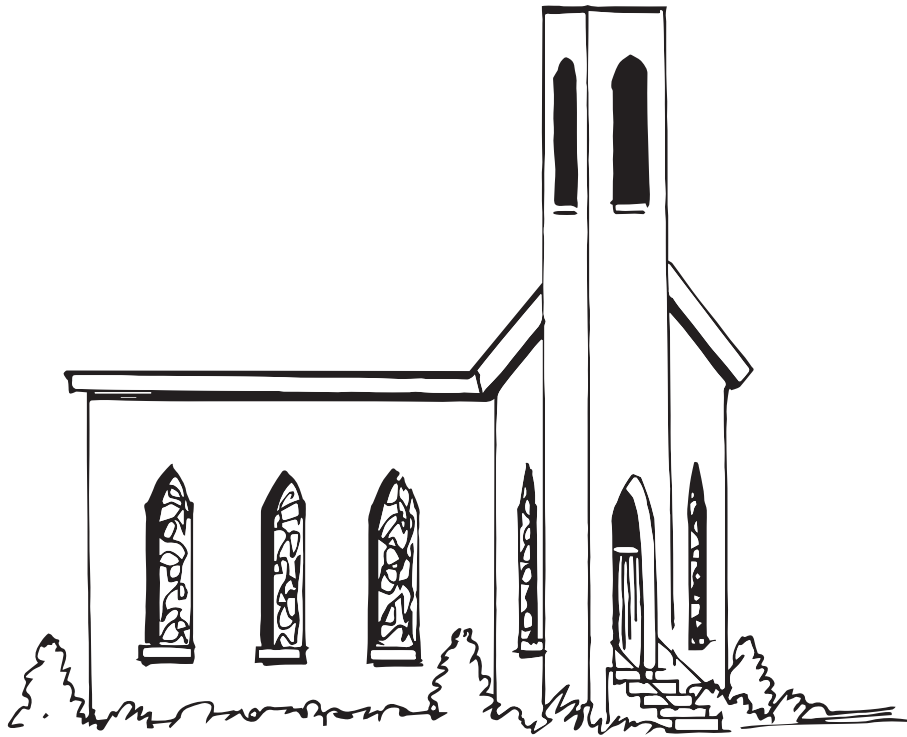


Look around your worship space. What objects, pictures, or symbols do you see that remind you that God loves and treasures you?

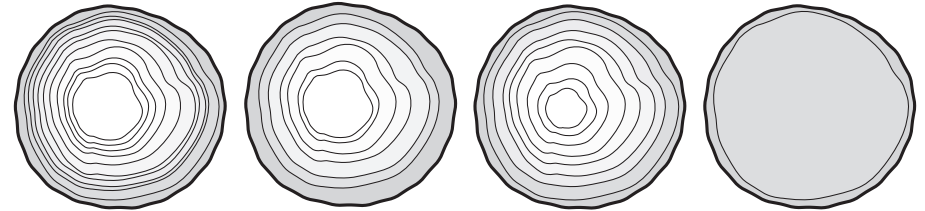

Pentecost 4

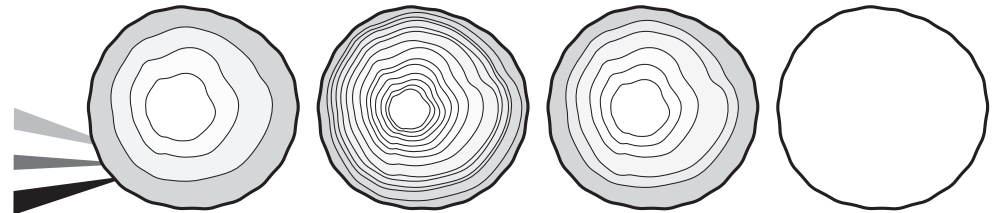
- Today is the **fourth** Sunday after Pentecost.

We can tell how old trees are by the number of rings in their trunk. Count how old these trees are. Then draw rings for how old YOU are!

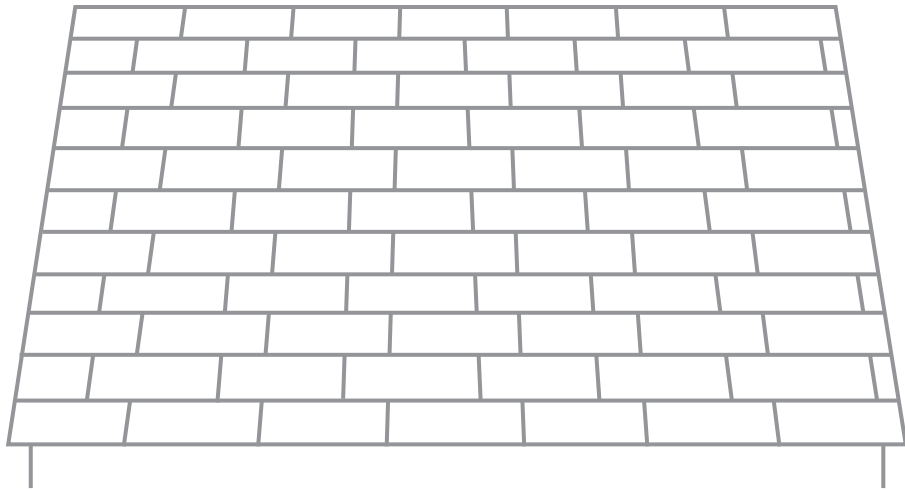
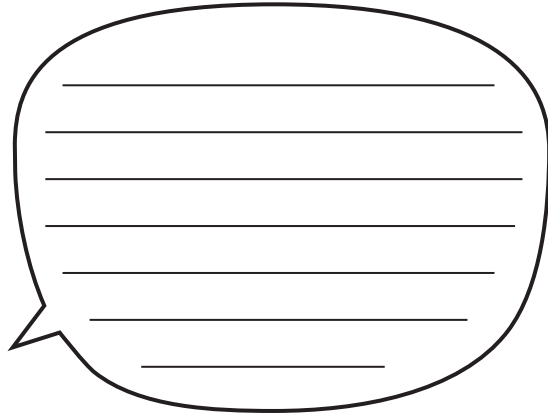

The Gospel of Matthew, where today's lesson comes from, was likely written between the years 80 and 90 A.D.

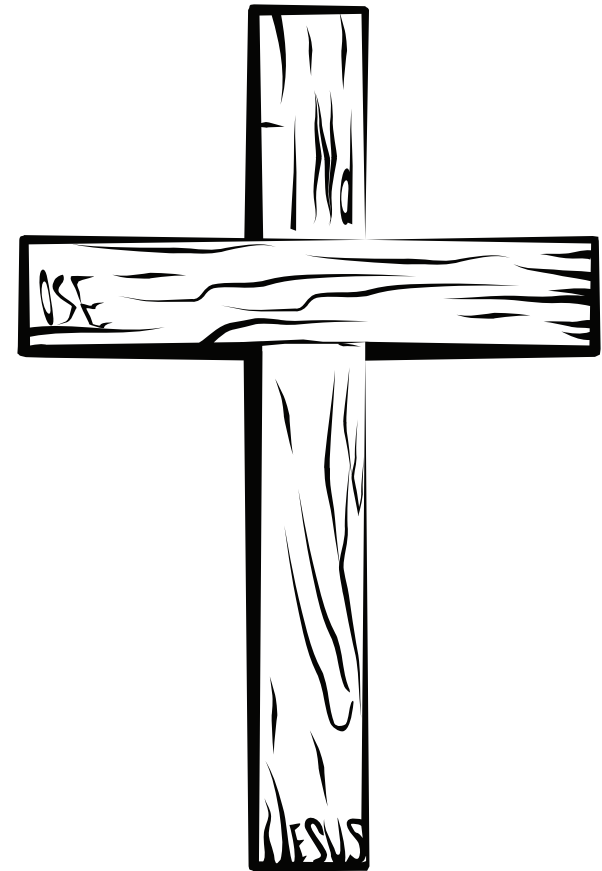


Find Your Life

In today's Bible story, Jesus tells us that "those who find their life will lose it, and those who lose their life for my sake will find it."

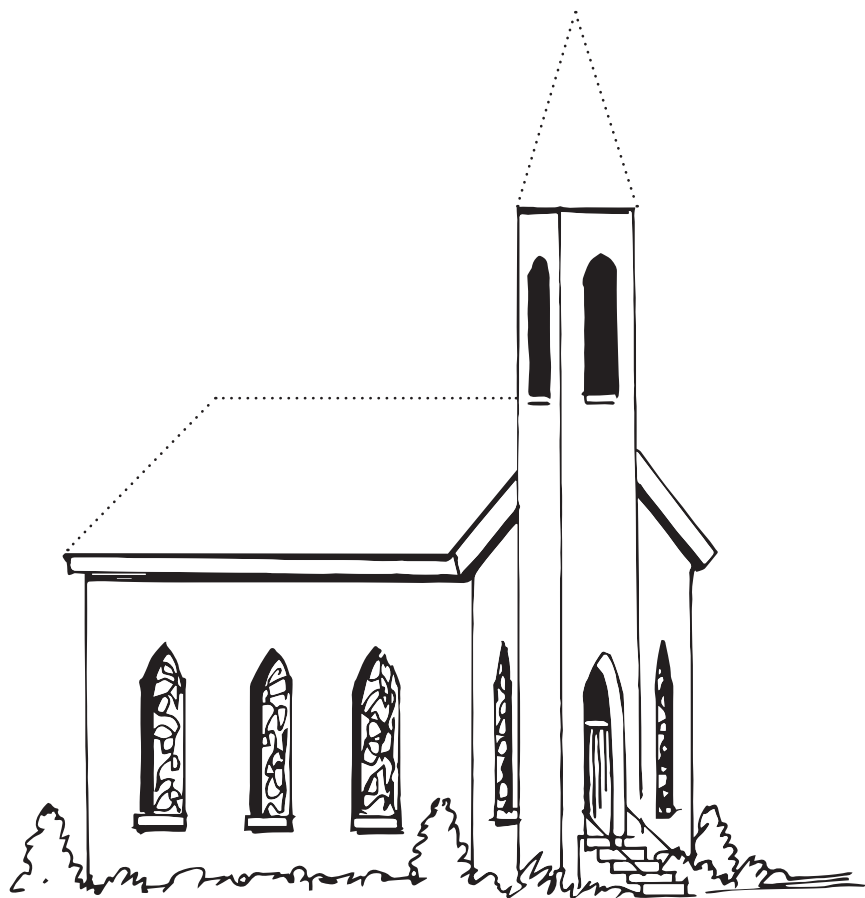
What do you think this means? What is Jesus asking us to do? Write what you think here.
