

More than enough!



Jesus took the five loaves and two fish, said a prayer, and gave the food back to the disciples. The disciples gave food to the hungry people. There was enough for everyone, with baskets left over.






- Today is the tenth Sunday after Pentecost.

Pentecost 10


- Today is the **10th Sunday** after Pentecost.
