During this Season of Creation, grant us courage to observe a Sabbath for our planet. Strengthen us with the faith to trust in your providence. Inspire us with the creativity to share what we have been given. Teach us to be satisfied with enough. Send Your Holy Spirit to renew the face of the ground. In your mercy, **hear our prayer**.
